



## The Integrity Academy Community School Scholarship Application

Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship at Integrity Academy. Please read the following information in order to familiarize yourself with the program and application process.

The goals of the Integrity Academy Scholarship program are:

- To increase economic and ethnic diversity among the student body;
- To make private school tuition affordable for well-deserving, highly motivated students and families who otherwise could not afford it.

Each scholarship request is reviewed by the Executive Director and the IA Foundation Board and is awarded based on both eligibility and funds available. A percentage of the school's operating budget is dedicated to scholarship discounts each year, and will be used to fund these individual agreements. These scholarship agreements are funded as part of the school's operating budget, and therefore funds available are limited. Please note that only complete applications will be considered.

All financial aid decisions are based on the following:

- Financial need;
- Student academic & leadership potential;
- The applicant's potential to help diversify the student body;
- Parental support and involvement in the community;
- The number of applicants and the amount of funds available to meet the individual requests

Applicants must have at least 2 of the 4 following requirements:

- Student must have demonstrated a dedication to the academic expectations of Integrity Academy and be involved in at least one extra-curricular activity, sport, or internship;
- Student's family must exhibit financial need. We usually consider financial need as a family income of \$35,000 or less for a single-parent family and \$60,000 or less for a two-parent family;
- Student fulfills the ethnic diversity requirement.
- Parent is willing to engage in our Work/Trade Option.

Students who receive scholarships must continue to demonstrate dedication to the development and progress of their education and be actively involved in the school, or they may lose their scholarship for the next year. If a student who has been awarded a scholarship should fail to demonstrate dedication to their experience at Integrity Academy, they will be put on financial aid probation.

The application process consists of two applications:

- The Integrity Academy Scholarship Application – submitted to Integrity Academy offices
- The FACTS Financial Analysis Application - submitted online directly to FACTS

Both forms must be submitted upon enrollment at Integrity Academy. Late forms may not be eligible for financial aid awards.
